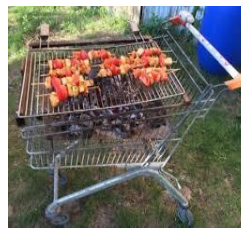


Coach Smithers has a serious losing season on his hands with the winless Wrinkle City High School's Fighting Scapegoats baseball team.

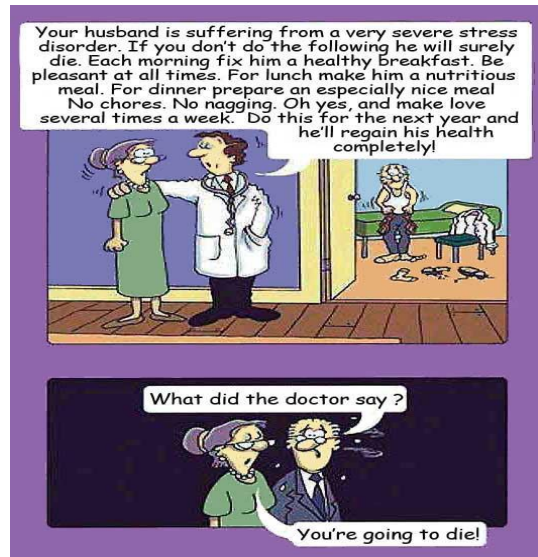
## Three Friends Pass

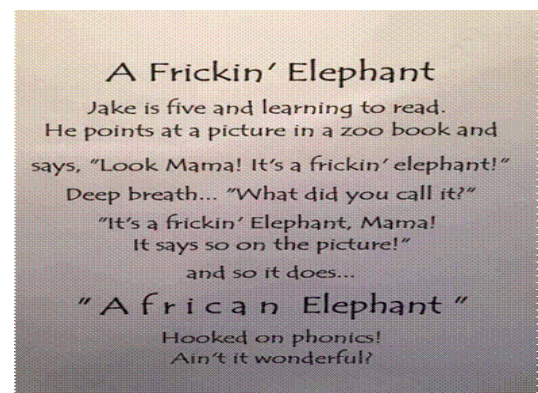
The first guy says, "I would like to hear them say that I was a great doctor of my time, and a great family man."

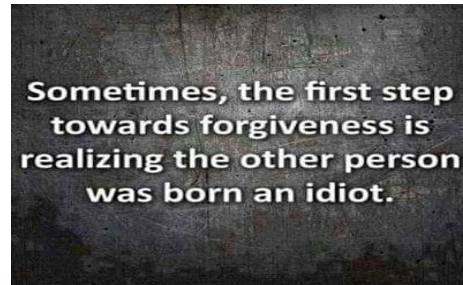

Paddy had long heard the stories of an amazing family tradition.

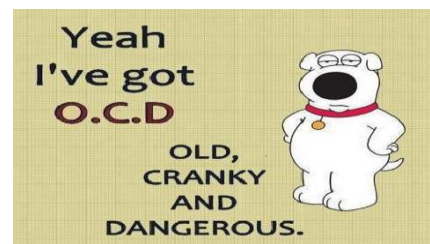
