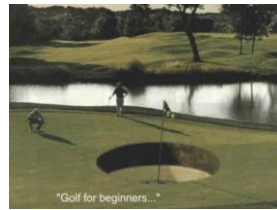


The planned events include diving for food stamps, playing “Who hid my work boots,” watermelon sucking, pig mud wrestling, the Honey Dipper 500 race, beer
