SS SOUHEY LAUNCHED AGAIN TO HELP CLEAN THE LAKES AND PONDS

Mayor Alton J. Souhey christened the 2016 re-launching of the floating muck scooper "SS Souhey" at Swift Run. The vessel was purchased by a local environmental group and



donated two years ago to the city to help eradicate lake scum and improve fishing of carp and catfish.

The vessel built by Bubba's Mobile Home and Marine Recreation Center in nearby Fletcher. The vessel has a control / living cabin with 40 gallon insulated beer cooler, a skimming platform and 20 hp outboard motor. The vessel will be able to be on the lake and operate 8 hours a day during the spring, summer and fall months unless it springs a leak or gets bogged down in the muck.

"We hope to get the muck out of the lake in 3 or 4 years," said Souhey. "It's a tedious process and our hand scoop is not that big," he said.

The boat can be rented out on the weekends when the city is not using it for 4 cases of good beer and a bag of weed according to someone inside of City Hall.

STREET REPAIR AND PATCHING AHEAD OF SCHEDULE

City crews have been grinding down worn pavement to get ready for paving. Junior Skidmore, assistant project manager, stated: "Unfortunately, it seems every other street



has been closed to grind down the pavement" said Skidmore. It's like a gigantic checkerboard. Citizens can't drive in a straight line to any place as half of the streets are torn up in sections. Earl spits overboard, takes a long, slow sip of beer and says,


